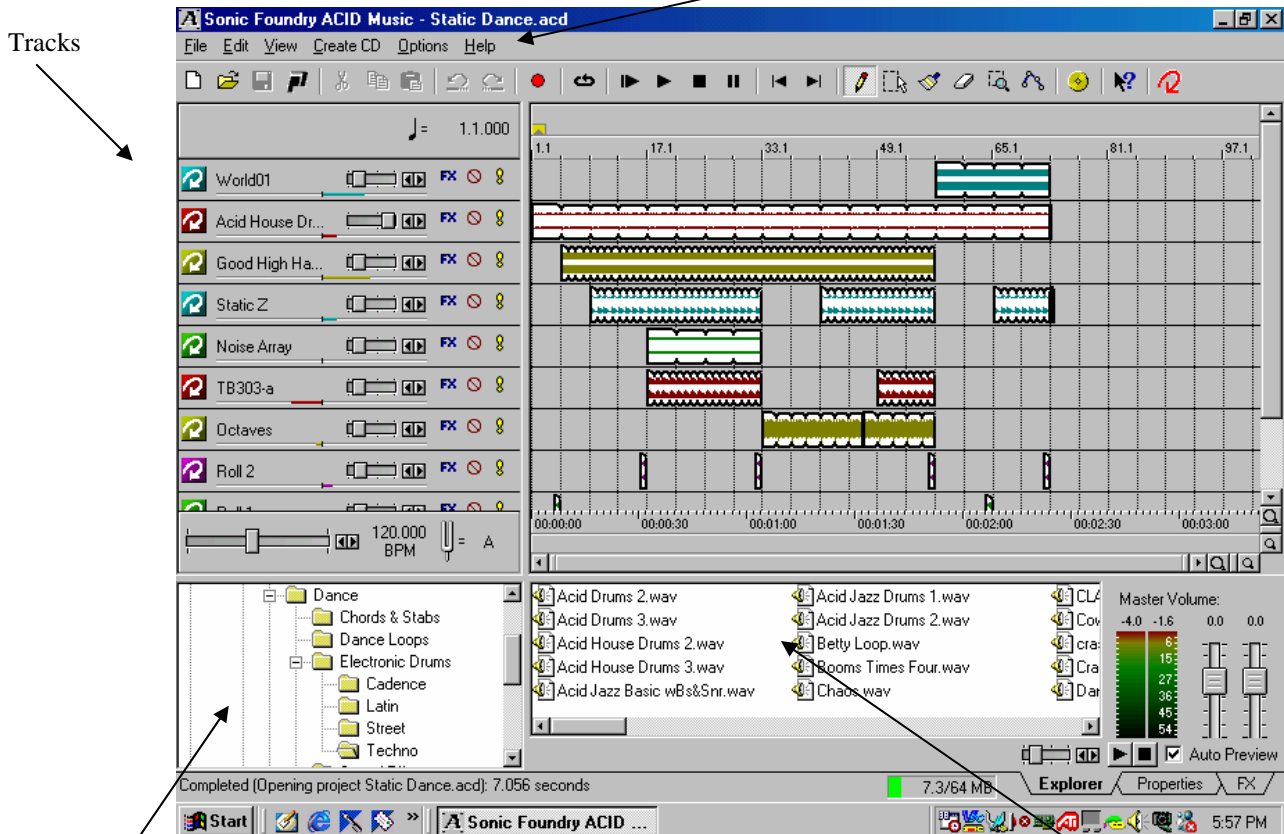
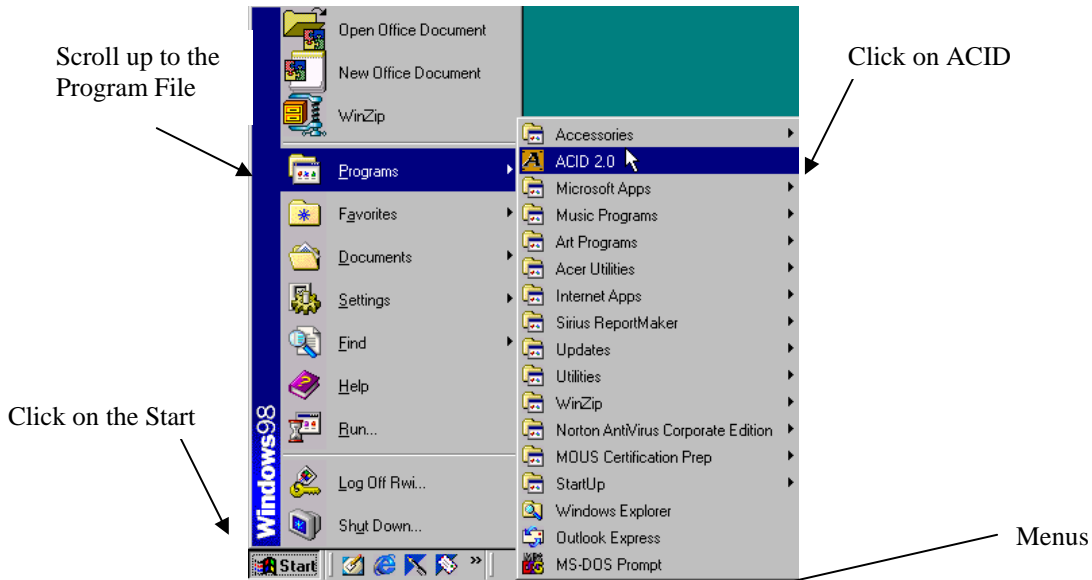


Acid Introduction

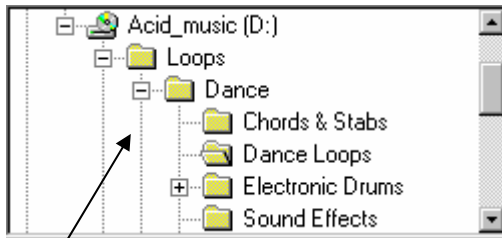

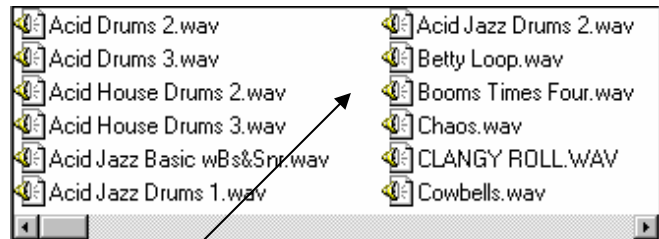

Creating a New song

1. *Select NEW in the Toolbar*
2. *Choose your music Loop folder from the file Directory*

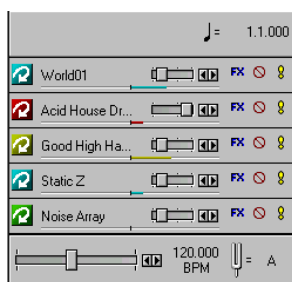

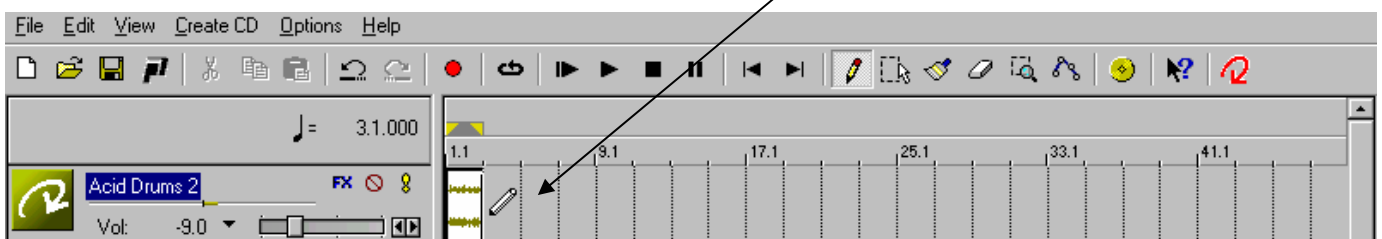
3. *Select wave files from the directory content*
4. *Click once on a wave to preview it*
5. *Waves can be controlled by the loop preview control*



6. *Double click on the wave you wish to use, it will then be found in the track list*

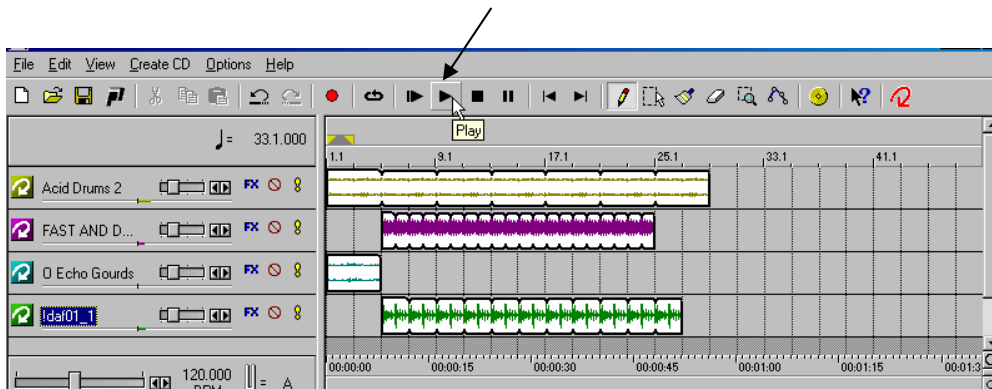


7. *Using the pencil tool click and drag the wave to the right*



8. Continue to add tracks to construct a composition

9. Press play to hear the composition



10. To erase tracks use to erase tool

11. To erase tracks from the track list, highlight the track, left click and select delete
